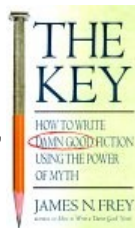
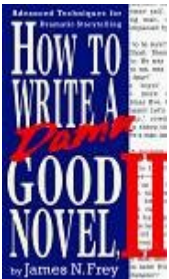
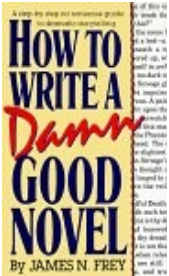
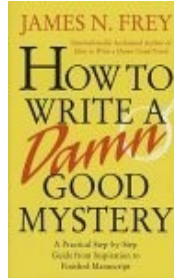
James N Frey is an award-winning Playwright and the author of *The Last Patriot*, *The Elixir* and *the Armageddon Game*.
